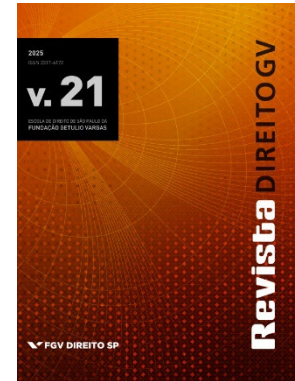


Law, Gender and Equality: A Special Issue
